



Business Class for about the price of coach, or less than Premium Economy, anyone? Everyone?

Do you avoid coach because it's coach, while shunning Business Class because of the price? Of course, not everyone wants to blow between \$4,000 and \$5,000 on a Business Class ticket. I'm with you on that and I always look hard for a \$2,000 ticket.

So imagine my smile when someone turned on the TAP to full power, spraying out a **\$1,224 Business Class ticket** across the pond and back. A deal like this raises some trade-off decisions you'll need to make, which are good problems to have if you ask me. For example, would I fly coach to the city I originally planned to visit or fly Business Class to a city I *wasn't* thinking of, but is actually really cool, for nearly the same price?

Through unconventional strategies and taking advantage of real options, you could save up to \$3,056, or 66%, over a regular Business Class flight.

UNCONVENTIONAL STRATEGIES REAP GUSHING BARGAINS

Flying Business Class for little more than coach is one of the holy grails of travel. It's like:

Buying a Picasso at a yard sale.

Getting a Wagyu tenderloin for the price of a top round roast.

Getting a free stop on the way to your destination with FCF's LSS or SLS strategies.

I could go on and on! If you haven't picked up the hints, this high-pressure hose of a deal comes courtesy of LifeMiles by offering TAP's New York-to-Lisbon route for 35,000 miles on the outbound flight. Even though the return flight is 63,000 miles, that's a total of 98,000 miles round-trip. So, you're netting round-trip travel for just \$1,349 (\$105 taxes included). If you take that one step further by subscribing to LifeMiles+, you can get this deal for just \$1,224. More on that below.

TAP routes from Miami and Washington, DC, to Lisbon and Newark to Porto have available award seats for 126,000 miles round-trip. Other Star Alliance carriers have available award seats for 126,000 miles round-trip, which is still pretty good.

THE FLOW OF MILES

LifeMiles offers bonus buy miles promotions **almost monthly**. The most recent one ended on May 31 and offered a bonus up to 160% at 1.27 cents a mile if you bought the maximum number of miles.

HOW DO I OPEN THE SPIGOT TO GET THE \$1,224 DEAL, BENNETT?

I'm glad you asked, although the deals above are still pretty great, right? Club LifeMiles is now offering a new [subscription plan](#) called LifeMiles+, which brings the price of an award ticket down further.

If you are a subscriber of LifeMiles+, you get 10% Star Alliance mileage credited back to your account. That brings the cost down to 88,200, or **\$1,224** (\$105 taxes included), for TAP's New York-Lisbon discounted flights. TAP routes from Miami and Washington, DC-Lisbon and Newark-Porto, and other Star Alliance carriers on flights to Europe cost 113,400, or \$1,544 (\$105 taxes included). Here are the details:

- Get 10% back on Star Alliance, Iberia, and GOL redemptions. Miles will be credited to your account within 15 days.
- Get up to 25% discount on Avianca mileage redemption flights.
- Get up to 10,000 miles per month, depending on the plan.
- Fee waiver for mileage redemption ticket changes (typically \$150) and refunds (typically \$200) on Basic, Pro, and Max plans.
- 24-month extended mileage expiration policy.
- Cancel your subscription after a minimum of six months.

Europe: 10 Ways to Fly Better than Fly Below the Radar

Through the upgrade looking glass

Our philosophy here at FCF is that there are *many* more ways to upgrade than merely winning the “gate lottery” (i.e. where an airline employee decides to move you up a cabin).

Bypassing the gate upgrade may seem counter-intuitive (excuse the pun), but not to savvy travelers (many of whom read these pages) who fly better, smarter, cheaper, more comfortably, and more rested.

We’ve written about this subject before (most recently [here](#) and [here](#)) because we’re passionate about opening travelers’ eyes to the possibilities we see every day. They don’t call me Mr. Upgrade for getting lucky

at the gate, they call me Mr. Upgrade because of all the different ways I upgrade. Let’s look at 10 examples of these hidden upgrade possibilities.

UPGRADE EXAMPLE #1: SHOPPING IN THE RIGHT STORE

Many travelers, especially “elite” travelers, go to their favorite airline websites and end up missing great flight opportunities as a result. For example, if you shop on Google Flights, look at the difference between these two Chicago-Prague Business Class fares: \$2,955 on Lufthansa, and \$5,097 on KLM. It’s nearly the same itinerary, but if you are a one-eyed SkyTeam alliance loyalist, you’d be paying \$2,142 more.

UPGRADE EXAMPLE #2: BETTER AIRLINE SEAT

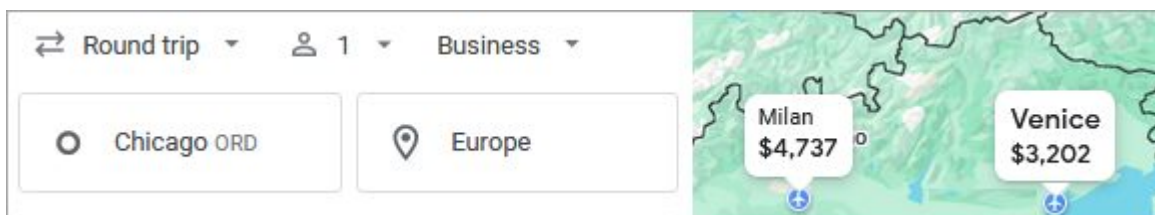
Most people don’t think about seat specifics when they’re booking flights, but a little inside knowledge makes a big difference in comfort, particularly when it’s a long-ish flight. Quick example: JetBlue’s EvenMore Space seats are roomier. They offer 38 inches of legroom while Virgin Atlantic’s Economy Delight is only 34 inches. As every hour ticks by, that extra legroom equals great value.

UPGRADE EXAMPLE #3: DESTINATION BLINDNESS

Most would think that flying to Venice is way more expensive than Milan, but that's not necessarily the case, as in this example. You can fly from Chicago to Milan for \$4,737, or to Venice and pay \$3,202, a \$1,535 savings for each person. Multiply that for a family trip and it covers a lot of gondola rides. And if it is Milan you want to visit, consider a train ride from Venice that rolls through scenic Veneto and Lombardy. The high-speed rail option takes right around a couple of hours.



UPGRADE EXAMPLE #4: CLASS OF SERVICE

Keep an eye on FCF's flash fares to get First Class fares for less than Business Class. As seen in the screenshots below, United's Business Class from New York to Rome goes for \$3,238, while American's **First Class** goes for \$3,014. That's an upgrade they're paying *you* to get.

That's what Doctor Seuss would call "Wacky Wednesday" because you'd be wacky to fly on that day if you could choose the days around it.

UPGRADE EXAMPLE #9: ADD A STOP

With [FCF's Hula Loophole](#), sometimes you can get two domestic destinations for the price of one with a free stopover. The key is to find a low-fare route that allows a free stopover. On the transcontinental route, you can make a free stop in Hawaii going west and stop in the Caribbean going east. If you have to stop, those are the places to do so. More about it [here](#).

For international destinations, we love the Leg Stretch Strategy (LSS), the Stopover Loophole Strategy (SLS), and the U-Turn Strategy.

The [LSS makes use of round-trip itineraries](#) between two continents with free stopovers each way on a third continent.

With the [SLS you can often add a side trip](#) that can lower your total airfare cost. That means you're actually *getting paid* to sneak in a great vacation in the middle of your trip! Sometimes, your side trip will come at a *small* additional cost (but it's still worth it).

UPGRADE EXAMPLE #10: EXPLORE POST-BOOKING UPGRADES

FCF always recommends grabbing your ticket when you come across a good deal or [something you can live with](#) — and if it's not perfect, [upgrade later](#). Oftentimes, canceling and rebooking without penalty is a go-to play for savvy travelers.

A PERFECT 10

There you have it, 10 ways to upgrade that you may not have considered. Just like having a menu full of destinations, it's best to have a quiver full of upgrade tactics and use the one that suits the moment. Pretty soon you'll become a bullseye traveler, nailing Olympic-level travel deals that will inspire the envy of your friends.

How to Get Business Class to South America and Europe on One Ticket from \$2,776

FCF'S LEG STRETCH STRATEGY STRETCHES ON

We've extolled the virtues of our **Leg Stretch Strategy** for many years now. While it's a nuanced offering, it offers quite spectacular savings. If your planets align for visiting two different continents other than the U.S. over a 12-month period (not so otherworldly, really) then it's a royal flush of a deal, and that's no stretch.

THE LEG STREEEEEEETCH ELEVATOR PITCH

Here's how it works. As mentioned, you can travel to two other continents, including two stops back in the U.S., all on one Business Class ticket at a massive price reduction from what you would pay if you bought these trips separately, as most travelers do.

We call it the Leg Stretch Strategy because you're stretching one ticket to get four legs of flying to all corners of the world. It's quite unique and very lucrative. The Leg Stretch always begins *outside* of the U.S. That means you need to get to its starting point, say, Europe, and then fly back to the U.S. at the end, or continue your next LSS itinerary from there. That will surely put some flyers off. But the savings way more than compensate for this cost, as many of our readers have happily discovered.

NANCY'S LEG STRETCH EXAMPLE: MILAN – CHICAGO – SÃO PAULO – CHICAGO – MILAN IN BUSINESS CLASS FOR \$2,776

It's a big 12 months ahead for Chicagoan Nancy. She's a fashion buyer keen to catch the two upcoming Milan Fashion Weeks – Fall/Winter and Spring/Summer. At the same time, her crazy buddy Nina said, "Let's go to Brazil! It's one of my bucket list countries. COME ON, Nancy!!" (Nina is impossible to turn down.) But Nancy had a problem: how the heck was she going to afford a trip to Italy AND Brazil? Nancy, meet MrUpgrade, your traveling fairy Godfather.

Let's break down Nancy's journey. The only rule is that the Leg Stretch part has to be completed within one year.

1. Nancy flies to Milan for Fall/Winter. She buys a one-way or an award ticket for that trip.

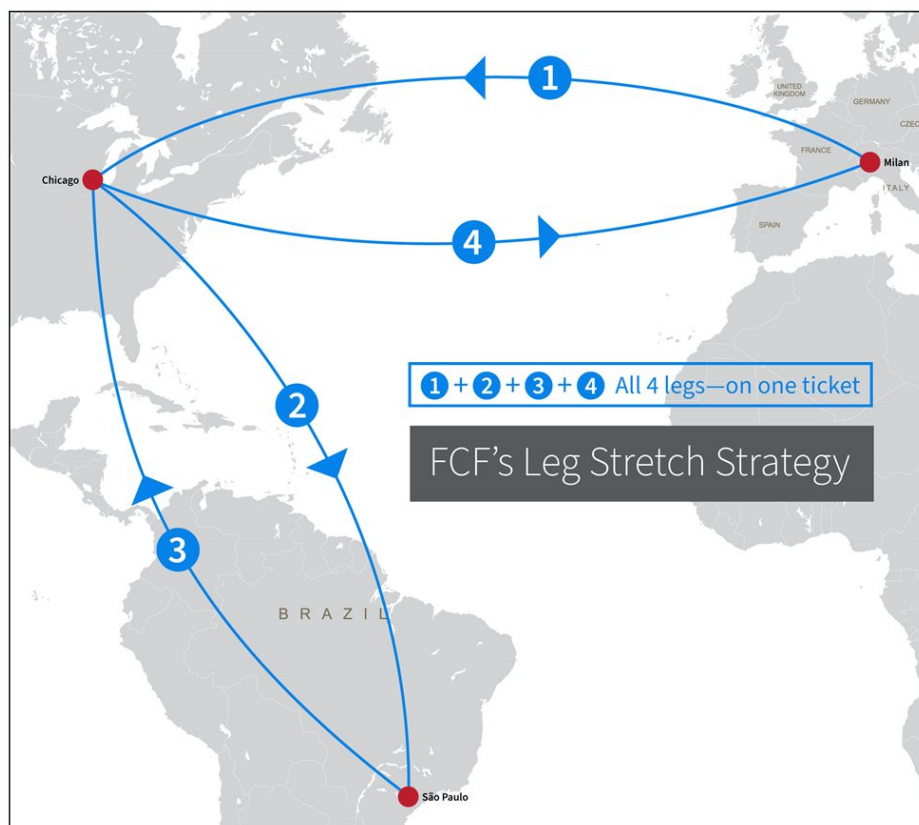
Nancy's Business Class One-Ticket \$2,776 Leg Stretch Starts Here

2. Starting her Leg Stretch Strategy, Nancy flies home to Chicago. She resumes normal life as a fashion buyer. That flight is **Leg 1 of the Leg Stretch**.
3. Weeks or months later, Nancy flies to São Paulo with Nina. That flight is **Leg 2 of the Leg Stretch**.
4. Nancy Returns home again. She's exhausted! That flight is **Leg 3 of the Leg Stretch**.

5. Nancy goes back to Milan. That flight is **Leg 4 of the Leg Stretch, completing the ticket.**

Nancy's Leg Stretch Strategy Ends Here. Screenshot below.

6. Finally, Nancy returns home to Chicago, buying a one-way ticket to do so, or starting another Leg Stretch – more on that below.



Now, if Nancy were to buy the separate legs of the Leg Stretch part of the journey (B, C, D, and E), in Business Class, she would pay \$11,980. So the strategy saves her a whopping \$9,204!

DOUBLE OR TRIPLE THE STRETCH

At the end of her Leg Stretch, Nancy actually has *two* options. She can embark on ANOTHER Leg Stretch ticket, or just get a ticket that takes her back home, as per flight F above. Let's break this down.

Option #1: Book *another* LSS Ticket. Once she's back in Europe, Nancy is already at the starting point of *another* LSS. Two Leg Stretches back-to-back will save you a designer wardrobe full of dollars.

Option #2: Head Home. If Nancy's all done with travel, she can buy a one-way ticket home, or she could have nested the Leg Stretch within a round-trip Chicago-Milan ticket.

FCF has examined lots of Leg Stretches including [Asia](#) and the [South Pacific](#).

HOW DOES THIS LOOK COMPARED TO FLYING IN ECONOMY?

Let's compare this Leg Stretch to a trip where those destinations are broken down into separate segments. In economy, the whole journey would cost around \$3,385 at the time of publication.

\$3,385 in economy versus \$2,776 in Business Class. That's a *savings* of **\$609, or 18%**. Nancy can put those savings toward the one-way flights, all while flying in **Business Class**. Lookin' good, Nancy!

HOW TO BOOK

You have several options but booking through a travel agent is best because an agent has easy access to inventory information. You can also use [Delta's](#) website or your favorite online booking engines such as [Google Flights](#), [Expedia](#), [Orbitz](#), or [Kayak](#). Make sure to use the multi-city search feature.

N.B. One thing to note is that these fares change frequently, and they're particularly volatile. So play with the dates a day or two (or 20) before and after each of the segments, and more than likely you'll find fares in the same range as we did.

See It and Raise It: Score Business for the Price of Premium Economy on KLM and Air France, Now

June 2024

In April, many readers were excited by our report about scoring Premium Economy tickets for the price of coach. Well, let's dial it up because Air France's current bonus buy promotion is dealing you a hot hand. See it and raise it — to Business Class!

As we mentioned back then, Flying Blue is the joint loyalty program of Air France, KLM, and a few other European airlines. With aces still abundant, we've kept Flying Blue on our radar.

WHAT'S THE DEAL WITH FARES?

Air France and KLM's fares are often highest when booked [within 14 days](#) of departure. However, unlike other major airlines, they are not following the status quo by offering [low summer fares](#) on many routes.

- **Air France**
 - **Chicago to Paris:** typical Business Class fares through late October range from \$4,280 to \$6,610+. From late October to April, fares range from \$2,900 to \$3,800.
- **KLM**
 - **Chicago to Amsterdam:** typical Business Class fares through late August and in September range from \$4,410 to \$6,330+. From late August and late October to April, fares range from \$3,280 to \$4,480.

Consider [positioning flights](#) when lucky low fares [are not offered on your route](#) or when you [don't have the minimum-stay requirement](#).

WHAT'S THE DEAL WITH MILES?

Air France and KLM both have a dynamic award pricing structure and have recently reduced the cost of awards on Air France to Paris and KLM to Amsterdam. Now they're starting at 50,000 miles each way on nonstop routes from the U.S.

ARE THE BIG 3 DEALING LOSING HANDS?

American Airlines charges between 47,000 and 145,000 miles for Premium Economy and between 62,000 and 400,000 for Business Class from New York to Paris, each way.

Delta Airlines ranges from 90,000 to 160,000 miles for Premium Economy and between 255,000 and 375,000 for Business Class, each way.

United Airlines' miles cost is between 76,400 and 120,000 for Premium Economy and between 140,000 and 175,000 for Business Class, each way.

LOW ON CHIPS? JUST BUY SOME MORE

Typical everyday mileage costs are around 2.44 cents each. But Flying Blue frequently offers mileage purchase bonuses. The current one runs through June 10 with a 70% bonus if you buy 100,000 miles (the maximum allowed per year) directly from the airline. This means you can get up to 170,000 miles with the bonus.

What does that mean, money-wise? Well, it works out to about 1.79 cents each. On KLM's Chicago-Amsterdam route that's a savings of up to \$2,028 / 46% when compared to typical published fares. That's a royal flush — [using a strategy we love](#) here at FCF.

We often talk about buying miles [when published premium fares are high](#), specifically when prices are hovering at \$4,000+ for Business Class international tickets. Here's a look at the savings:

A TABLE FULL OF TRANSFER PARTNERS

Air France/KLM's Flying Blue loyalty program has lots of points-to-miles transfer partners including Amex Rewards, Capital One, Chase, and Citi.

You can buy up to 500,000 annually from Amex Membership Rewards for 2.5 cents each and transfer them to Flying Blue. Check out FCF's [How to buy American Express Membership Rewards points](#), and [Beginner's Guide: how to play the "Buy Miles to Fly In Style"](#).

Air France and Amex offer transfer bonuses periodically. Their most recent bonus last September was 25%. This brings the mileage transfer cost down from 100,000 to just 75,000 miles for a round-trip ticket in Business Class.

MILEAGE AWARD TAXES

Air France/KLM typically charges around \$588 in taxes for Business Class awards, round-trip, although it varies by route.

NOT FLYING TO PARIS OR AMSTERDAM? CALL THE AIRLINE'S BLUFF WITH A CONNECTING FLIGHT

You can fly almost anywhere in Europe on one ticket. Air France and KLM offer awards that allow connections on the flights they operate, as well as their partners. That means you can add on the following destinations (as long as they're available beyond Paris or Amsterdam with the airline or its partners): Croatia, Denmark, France, Germany, Greece, Italy, Poland, Spain, Switzerland, UK, and more. That's a pretty nice European bucket list selection.

When booking a connecting flight, check each segment separately first, starting with the most important over-the-water flight. You can add a connection to your nonstop route (depending on availability). However, you will have to spend more miles to add these connecting flights.

High Business Class Fares Got You Down? Try the Low-Fare Route Sidestep Hustle

June 2024

Business Class fares are a mixed bag these days. We're finding great fares one day, and *grate* fares the next. Well, they grate on my nerves when I see them. So it got us thinking — what if we got a bit lateral about the departure and arrival cities? Instead of just accepting the high fare, why not cast your net a little wider in terms of the cities you leave from and arrive to? Sometimes an alternative city is surprisingly close and offers a much better fare — which would way more than cover the cost of the short trip to get there.

This “sidestep hustle” is a handy hack when fares are high out of a major U.S. city like Chicago or New York. Let's look at some examples.

SIDESTEP HUSTLE #1 ALTERNATE U.S. DEPARTURE CITY

A typical Business Class fare on American Airlines from Chicago to Frankfurt is \$5,426. Instead, you could sidestep to Milwaukee and fly from there to Frankfurt in Business Class on American for only \$3,361. Milwaukee is just 67 miles from Chicago, a short trip for a \$2,065, or 38%, savings. That could be a short “[positioning flight](#)” or even a car trip. Either way, you’re well ahead.
